Jesus Christ, More Than a Carpenter | Guest Speakers. **This is hosted by McClung in Room 026.**

Introduction to the Acts of the Disciples | In one sense ACTS is the most important book in the New Testament. It is the simple truth that if we did not possess ACTS we would have no information (outside of Paul's letters) about the early church. In this study we will explore "How the Good News was brought from Jerusalem to Rome." **This class is hosted by Little Bacon in Room 020.**

Revelation | This study by Dr W Robert Godfrey with Ligonier Ministries offers a rich vision of blessing and encouragement to God's people in every generation.
