
Summer Sunday Adult Class at 9:45 am

This class will challenge you to sit at the feet of our Lord to smell the aroma of Jewish villages, to feel the dust of Galilean roads, and to listen to these wonderful stories as though you were hearing them for the first time. 


Quarterly Legacy Campaign Update:

We still have open slots for participants to help complete our collaborative "Encounters with Jesus" painting—and we'd love to see your creativity on the canvas!


