


Join us on Sunday, November 9, at 3:00 p.m. in the North Atrium for the next performance in our Musical Offerings Concert Series.

Emmanuel Slavic Church: A Joyful Farewell

Sunday, November 2nd, marked a new chapter for Emmanuel Slavic Church. After worshiping with us for several months, they have purchased their own building at East Sunshine and Route 125.

Their journey has been remarkable. Just a few weeks ago, they had \$18,000 in the bank—far short of the \$170,000 needed to close. But through prayer, persistence, and the generosity of other churches across the country, every dollar was provided. They closed on October 21st, earlier than expected.

Their faith and joy have been steady and contagious. Many of their members came to Springfield after enduring hardship in Ukraine, yet they carried peace and gratitude wherever they went. Their time with us was a quiet testimony to the goodness of God and a reminder of our mission: to labor alongside our Father as He draws people to Jesus and grows them as disciples.

We celebrate with them and give thanks for the part we were able to play in their story. May God bless Emmanuel Slavic Church as they continue to reach the Slavic community here in Springfield with the hope of Christ.

Families receiving support go through a qualifying process for participation, and volunteers who serve them get to walk with them as they select toys and are given groceries they take home to make their holiday meal.
