College and Young Adult Dinner & Bible Study | Starting Wednesday, Sept. 10th, join us weekly for dinner at 5 PM followed by Bible study at 6 PM in the Fellowship Hall. We study scripture using the Discovery Bible Study method.

The Circle | This women's group meets the 4th Tuesday of every month at 1pm in Rm 114 and is studying are currently studying Angels Standing Guard by Douglas Connelly.

Men's Bible Study | Meeting Tuesdays at 7pm in Rm. 015, this group is studying Paul's Letter to the Romans through a verse-by-verse video series by Dr. W. Robert Godfrey. This study inspires believers to boldly proclaim, "I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes."

Hebrews Women's Study | This group meets Thursday nights in Rm. 020 beginning Sept. 11 6:30-8pm for 10 weeks. In this verse-by-verse study of the Book of Hebrews, Jen Wilkin shows how God "provided something better for us" in Jesus Christ (Heb. 11:40). Using stories of Old Testament heroes and practices, the author of Hebrews reveals the new covenant's superiority and how Jesus fulfills every promise.

Table Talk | This Women's Bible Study meets in Rm. 114 on Fridays from noon- 2pm. This small group values our Jewish roots and studies Scripture verse by verse. This year, we're studying the Book of 2 Samuel using devotions from *Tabletalk* magazine (Ligonier Ministries). Each week begins with a potluck lunch, prayer, and sharing.
